SALT CONFERENCES

The Great Lakes Area SALT Conference was held in Fort Wayne IN Jan 2nd-5th. About 600 students and staff attended. The Lord met us and changed lives throughout the services. Bill Shrader missionary to Peru also attended this conference. Bill was my assistant SALT director doing this same conference for 15 years. We had a great time together. He and his wife Lena have been in Peru for 8 years. It was a great time for us to enjoy the SALT ministry time without concerns for logistics!
